
CHAPTER 144 – PUBLIC LANDS, USE OF

Sec. 144-5 Use of conservation areas.

Conservation areas shall be open to the general public, but no horses and no vehicles of any kind, whether powered or unpowered, shall be permitted thereon, except baby-strollers and wheelchairs or equipment needed by individuals with disabilities. Furthermore, bicycles shall be allowed in conservation areas, subject to the Conservation Commission's discretion and authority to prohibit bicycles from specific sensitive areas. ~~, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, bicycles.~~ Such areas shall be used only in a manner consistent with their designation as conservation areas. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in any conservation area where a specific use is permitted, such as farming or boat launching at Walker Farm, such use shall be considered a permitted use in such area.
